The community has been an active force in promoting and contributing towards the scholarship program. The scholarships allow students in need to have equal and adequate education rather than focusing on financial issues.	
Actual Measurable Outcomes for Plan 2008 Goals, Including Impact on Enrollment, Retention, and/or Graduation, and/or long term potential thereof: 1) Positive connections grew with community organizations; 2) students usually stay the 2 nd year to receive the scholarship as well as be an an active participate in the UMA student organization; and 3) students have shown great leadership, motivation, and dedication toward their campus, education, and community.	
Intersections Across Plan 2008 Goals: To increase the amount of financial aid available to needy students and to reduce students' reliance on loans.	
Assessment Practices and Program Changes in Response to Challenges: Track and monitor success rates of students who receive scholarships.
