Description: Three event programs, involving potential UWSP students who meet admission criteria, are organized to enable students to: 1) foster team building and leadership development while increasing student familiarity with UWSP resources and campus community (summer); 2) acquaint themselves with academic programs, participate in a campus preview, meet current UWSP students and familiarize themselves with UWSP campus life (fall) 3) encourage admissions for students who are admitted but not enrolled in UWSP by meeting academic program staff, discuss issues of incoming students and experience UWSP campus life (spring).

Goals & Expected Outcomes: Increase the diversity student population enrolled at UWSP Outcome: increase diversity students from WI metro areas. Students who participate in the summer leadership camp will apply for admission to UWSP Students who inquire, apply and are admitted will increasingly enroll in UWSP.	
Actual Measurable Outcomes for Plan 2008 Goals, Including Impact on Enrollment, Retention, and/or Graduation, and/or long term potential thereof: Approximately 90% of the summer participants apply for admission to UWSP. The number of African American (59 to 85 students), SE Asian (66 to 131 students) and Hispanic/Latino (63 to 87) students has progressively increased since 2002.	
Intersections Across Plan 2008 Goals: Foster institutional environments that respect diversity; improve retention of targeted populations; prevent social isolation of diversity students at UWSP.	
Assessment Practices and Program Changes in Response to Challenges: Program participant feedback for the 3 programs will be solicited in 2007. Funding source is not reliable. 2203 funding cuts resulted in a program deficit
