# Family Incomes of UW Resident New Freshmen

# Wisconsin Covenant Requirements

- Demonstrate financial need by meeting income requirements
- Meet academic requirements while in high school
- Exhibit good citizenship

# Income Eligibility Options

- Lowest income quintile (2004: below \$29,000)
- Lowest two income quintiles (2004: below \$47,000)
- Qualify for Federal Free Lunch Program/130% of poverty level (2005: below \$25,000\*)
- Qualify for Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program/185% of poverty level (2005: below \$36,000\*)

\* Income based on a family of four

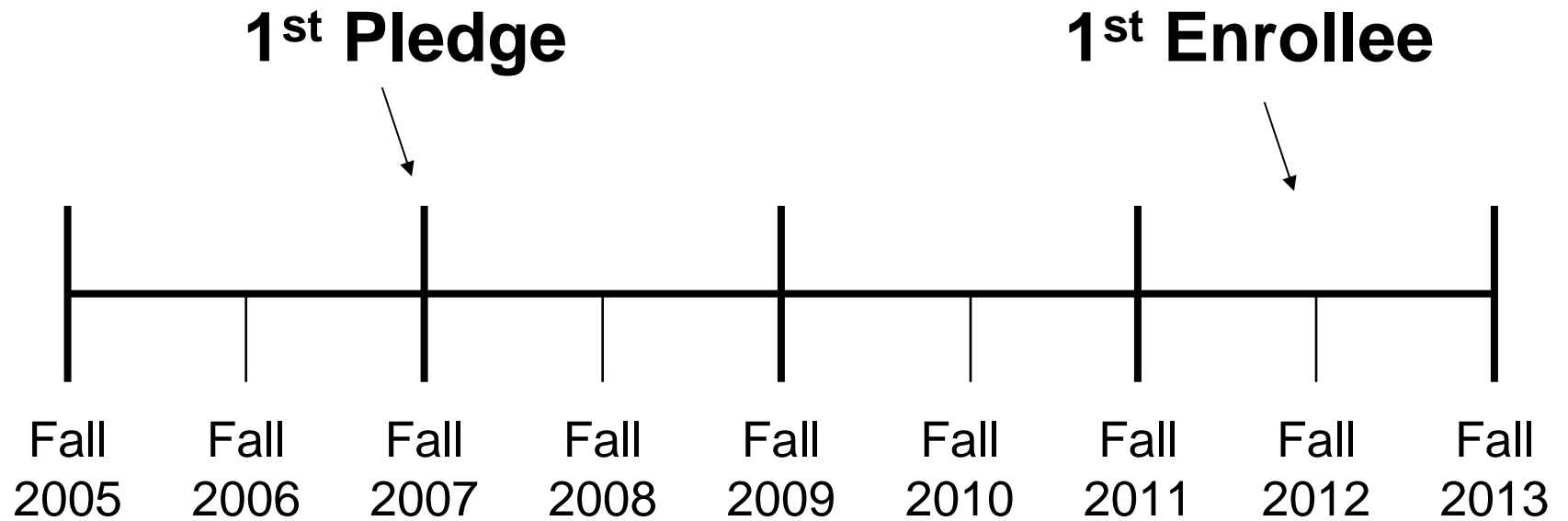
# Academic Options

- Successfully complete college preparatory coursework while in high school
- Meet minimum high school grade point average or rank in class
- Graduate from a Wisconsin high school
- Meet UW admissions criteria

# Good Citizenship Options

- Perform community service
- Stay out of trouble/no illegal activity

- Provide additional financial aid support targeted to the most financially needy UW students
- Ensure tuition/fees are covered
