

STARS Data Field Definitions

Worker's Compensation Standard Reports

Payment Types

Med = Medical; medical expenses, including chiropractic, physical therapy, x-ray, prescriptions, mileage, doctor visits, hospital

Ind = Indemnity; wage replacement costs on lost time claims, e.g., Temporary Total Disability (TTD), Temporary Partial Disability (TPD)

Expense = costs for copying medical records, medical case management, independent medical exams

Recovery = recouped costs from third party subrogation, payments paid by mistake fact

Deductible & Legal: not used for workers compensation

Other = costs for permanent partial disability (PPD) and permanent total disability (PTD)

Claim Types

INCD = Incident Only; a minor occurrence with no current medical costs or lost work time. An INCD (incident only) claim can develop into a compensable claim.

LT = Lost Time; the work injury/illness results in an absence from work

MED = Medical Only; the work injury/illness resulted in only medical treatment costs

HAZ = Hazardous Duty; the work injury/illness resulted from activity relating to public safety under ss 230.36

NRMS = Near Miss; a work related occurrence that *could* have resulted in injury, e.g., narrowly missed being hit by a falling object. A NRMS (near miss) claim will **not** develop into a compensable claim.

Other Financial

Res = Reserve; total estimated cost of the claim

Incurred = reserve plus paid

Paid = total of all payment types, i.e. Med+ Ind+ Expense+ Other – Recovery=Paid

Outstanding = incurred minus paid, i.e. balance remaining
