TRANSFER INFORMATION SYSTEM

The Transfer Information System (TIS)

is a web-based interactive program that allows University of Wisconsin System and Wisconsin Technical College System students and advisers to see how credits will transfer to any UW or WTCS campus.

This student-friendly website is full of current, accurate information, including a comprehensive collection of links and resources to use while planning a successful transfer process.

CREDIT TRANSFER WIZARD

Use the Credit Transfer Wizard to see how courses you are taking — and even courses you plan to take — will transfer to any UW campus.

- Just pick the course numbers from a “pull down” list to view information about how courses transfer.
- Use the “reverse look-up” feature to find courses at another campus that you can take during the summer to fulfill requirements at your school.
- Learn what courses you can take at your current campus to fulfill general education requirements (e.g., humanities, science) at your intended transfer campus.
