### Week of April 28 - May 4

#### Position

Pete Berg, UW-Oshkosh Jr. OF Janesville (Craig)

#### Position

Brad Demmin, UW-Oshkosh Jr. 1B Oshkosh (North)  
 Demmin hit .424 (14-33) with four home runs and 16 RBIs as UW-Oshkosh won all eight of its games, including a doubleheader sweep of No.22-ranked UW-Stevens Point. Rubens allowed nine hits and only two unearned runs while coming in relief in all five games. He struck out six batters and walked just two as opponents hit only .176 off of him. Rubens picked up a pair of wins in UW-Oshkosh victories of 7-6 (11 innings) and 7-5 (11 innings) over UW-La Crosse on April 14.
